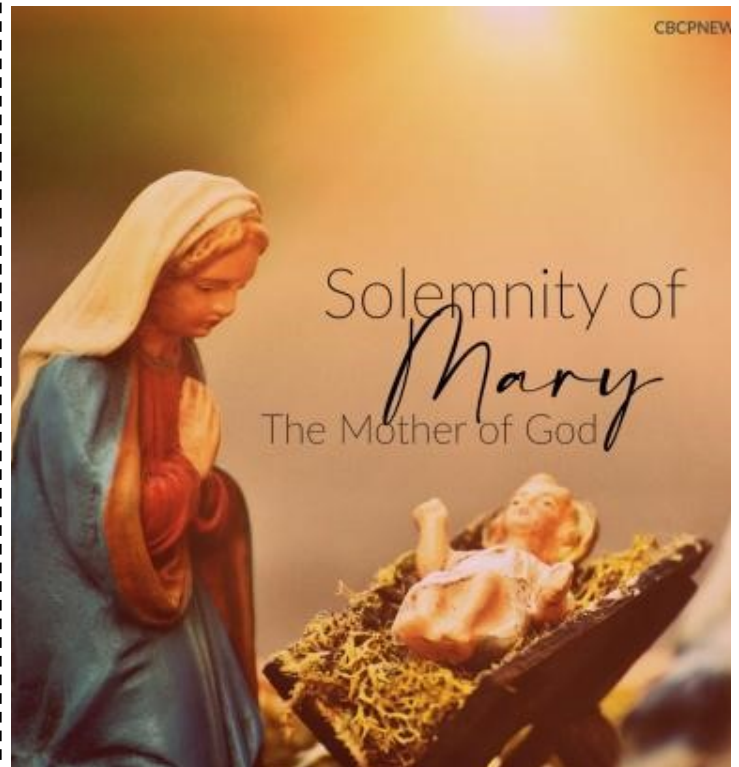

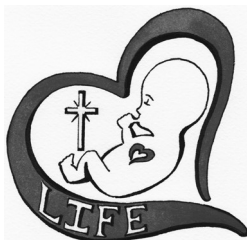

### Reporting Suspected Abuse

*If you suspect a child or vulnerable adult is being abused or neglected, make a report to the Kansas Department for Children and Families Protection Report Center by calling (800) 922-5330. If you or someone you know has been abused by a cleric, employee, or volunteer of any archdiocesan parish, school, or agency — regardless of when the abuse may have occurred — call the archdiocesan confidential report line at (913) 647-3051 or the victim Care Advocate at (913) 298-9244, after calling local law enforcement. You can also make a report using the online form at: [www.archkck.org/reportabuse](http://www.archkck.org/reportabuse). The Archdiocese of Kansas City in Kansas places the protection of children as its priority. The archdiocese respects the sincere concerns of all individuals who report misconduct and is committed to conducting thorough investigations of all allegations.*

## Prolife Limit Blocked

Another Real & Tragic Consequence of the "No" vote against Value Them Both.



On Nov 23, another Kansas protective limit was blocked by a judge after it was challenged by the abortion industry. The "Trust Women" abortion clinic in Wichita was the plaintiff in the case to remove the in-person doctor requirement for chemical abortions. As Kansans for Life stated in their press release:

Kansans need to be informed of the dangers of this removal of the in-person doctor requirement, namely:

1. Endangering the life of the mother from an undiagnosed ectopic pregnancy
2. Endangering the life of the mother from an unsupervised, failed chemical abortion, with no doctor on premises to provide continuation of care for a woman experiencing rapidly deteriorating physical condition
3. Increased risk of excruciating pain for a later term unborn child, due to a lack of doctor's confirmation of the baby's gestational age.

This is a sad and tragic consequence of the "No" vote and is further evidence that abortion is not healthcare for women. The abortion industry puts its desire to maximize profits over its care for women. The loss of this protection is the modern version of "back-alley" abortions.

Let us pray for the intercession of Our Lady of Guadalupe, for the protection of all pre-born children and the dignity and safety of all women faced with an unplanned or difficult pregnancy.

Currently the three protective limits that have been blocked since the 2019 KS Supreme Court ruling - the ban on live dismemberment abortion, clinic licensing and inspection requirements, and the in-person doctor requirement - are all on appeal.
